



Golf Course Maintenance Team (Part-time)

Overview

Job Description

The Golf Course Maintenance Crew members will assist Golf Course Superintendent in day-to-day mowing, raking, weed eating, edging, watering and changing cups. Members of the Golf Course Maintenance Team are responsible for the maintenance of the golf course, including mowing, trimming, bunker raking, weed eating, edging, watering, changing cups and miscellaneous grounds work. Individuals should have a strong work ethic and effective communication skills, demonstrate flexibility, show enthusiasm and take initiative. Applicants should be of good character and reputation, and have a desire to carry out the mission of First Tee by mentoring to youth.

Essential Functions

- The Golf Course Maintenance Crew members will assist Golf Course Superintendent in day to day mowing, raking, weed eating, edging, watering and changing cups.
- Maintaining good communication with the Superintendent and notifying them of problems (ie. disease, damage, drainage, irrigation, etc. on the golf course, greens or practice areas.
- Maintain cleanliness of the maintenance shop and assisting maintenance staff where appropriate.
- Check water levels and cups at water stations.
- In the event of medical emergencies, call for help, assist the injured, and contact the Pro-Shop with information.
- Help Clubhouse staff with deliveries outside services, or other tasks requested by Management.
- Familiar with irrigation systems, knowledge of pesticides and fertilizers is helpful
- Golf Course Maintenance Team Members will be required to work outside in the elements and may be exposed to the weather, pollen, dust and insects.

20 - 25 Hours per week

Typical Shift – 6:00am – 1:00pm weekdays & weekends

Qualifications

High School Diploma/GED

Golf Course experience preferred, but not required.

Pay Rate - \$9.00/hour.
